The wilderness is a place:

- The Law was given we must learn God's word

The wilderness is a place:

- Where the Tabernacle was erected and the Priesthood established – we must learn to worship
- Where the people were numbered we must learn order and discipline

- Only after all of these things took place, would they be ready to go to the promise land!
- The bible teaches that these things became our examples (1 Corinthians 10:6).



- Their faith tested (no water, no food, manna from heaven, etc.)
- They won battles (they were attacked for no reason, etc.)

Exo 20:13 "You shall not commit adultery."





Definition:

 Voluntary sexual intercourse between a married person and a person who is not his or her spouse.

Definition:

• Synonyms: unfaithfulness, infidelity, falseness, disloyalty, unchastity, extramarital sex, extramarital relations, affair, liaison, intrigue, amour, entanglement, flirtation, cheating, twotiming, fooling around, playing around, playing the field, carryings-on, hankypanky, a bit on the side, fornication

Definition:

The act of adultery is a grave sin!
 Don't be fooled by the way the world treats this act. It is an awful thing.

Pro 6:23 - For the commandment is a lamp,
And the law a light;
Reproofs of instruction are the way of life,

Pro 6:24 - To keep you from the evil woman,
From the flattering tongue of a seductress.

Pro 6:25 - Do not lust after her beauty in your heart,
Nor let her allure you with her eyelids.

Pro 6:26 - For by means of a harlot A man is reduced to a crust of bread; And an adulteress will prey upon his precious life.

Pro 6:27 - Can a man take fire to his bosom,
And his clothes not be burned?

Pro 6:28 - Can one walk on hot coals, And his feet not be seared?

Pro 6:29 - So is he who goes in to his neighbor's wife;
Whoever touches her shall not be innocent.

Pro 6:30 - *People* do not despise a thief If he steals to satisfy himself when he is starving.

Pro 6:31 - Yet when he is found, he must restore sevenfold;
He may have to give up all the substance of his house.

Pro 6:32 - Whoever commits adultery with a woman lacks understanding;
He who does so destroys his own soul.

Pro 6:33 - Wounds and dishonor he will get,
And his reproach will not be wiped away.

Pro 6:34 - For jealousy *is* a husband's fury;
Therefore he will not spare in the day of vengeance.

Pro 6:35 - He will accept no recompense,
Nor will he be appeased though you give many gifts.

There is also another aspect of adultery – adultery of the heart

Mat 5:27 -"You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY.'

Mat 5:28 - But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her *in his heart.*

Mat 5:29 - If your right eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast it from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell.

Mat 5:30 - And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and cast it from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell.





Gen 34:1 - Now Dinah the daughter of Leah, whom she had borne to Jacob, went out to see the daughters of the land.

Gen 34:2 - And when Shechem the son of Hamor the Hivite, prince of the country, <u>saw her</u>, he took her and lay with her, and violated her.


Gen 39:7 - And it came to pass after these things that his master's wife <u>cast</u> <u>longing eyes</u> on Joseph, and she said, "Lie with me."


2Sa 11:2 - Then it happened one evening that David arose from his bed and walked on the roof of the king's house. And from the roof he saw a woman bathing, and the woman was very beautiful to behold.

1Jn 2:15 - Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

1Jn 2:16 - For all that *is* in the world—the lust of the flesh, *the lust of the eyes*, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

1Jn 2:17 - And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.





Mat 12:34 - Brood of vipers! How can you, being evil, speak good things? For out of the *abundance of the heart* the mouth speaks.

Mat 12:35 - A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things.

Mat 15:17 - Do you not yet understand that whatever enters the mouth goes into the stomach and is eliminated?

Mat 15:18 - But those things which proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and they defile a man.

Mat 15:19 - For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies.

Mat 15:20 - These are the things which defile a man, but to eat with unwashed hands does not defile a man."

Jas 1:13 - Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.

Jas 1:14 - But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his <u>own</u> <u>desires</u> and enticed.

Jas 1:15 - Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.



As believers we are in a covenant relationship with God. Jesus is the bridegroom and the church is the bride.

Rev 19:7 - Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready."

Rev 21:9 - Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife."

To serve another God, is adultery against God!



Gal 5:19 - Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: <u>adultery</u>, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness,

Gal 5:21 - envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

1Co 6:9 - Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites,

1Co 6:10 - nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.
